God's Prophetic Time Clock

I mentioned in the previous E-Week that the next time together we would discuss what it means "to occupy until I come." Jesus made it clear when we saw all of the prophetic events taking place, to occupy until He comes. The Bible tells us in 1st Thessalonian, 5th chapter, "But of the times and the seasons, brethren, ye have no need that I write unto you. For yourselves know perfectly that the Day of the Lord so cometh as a thief in the night. For when they shall say, peace and safety; then sudden distraction cometh upon them, prevail upon a woman with a child; and they shall not escape. Ye brethren, are not in darkness, that that day should overtake you as a thief. Ye are all the children of the light, and the children of the light; we are not of the night, nor of darkness. Therefore let us not sleep, as do others; but let us watch and be sober. For they that sleep, sleep in the night; and they that be drunken are drunken in the night. But let us, who are of the day, be sober, putting on the breastplate of faith and love; for an helmet, the hope of salvation." The Bible makes it clear because we have the Word of God, the Word makes it clear as to what will be taking place in the latter days.

So, because of the truth revealed in the Bible, as believers we should be in the know and we should be in the light. We have been told directly from God through His Word exactly what will take place in the closing Age of Grace prior to the Rapture of the church. Yet, as the Bible says, most believers are asleep, and the Word tells us that as the thief cometh in the night, so will Christ return to this earth in the fullness of time. Yet, God intended for us to know. Why would He devote 25% of the entire Word of God towards prophesy if He did not think it was important for us to be in the know? We have to ask ourselves the question, Are we in darkness and ignorance, lack of knowledge? Could it be that we have heard this for years and years so we've become complacent and hardened about this issue. Or, maybe it could be that really we do not want Christ to return, that might upset our selfish pursuits on this earth.

In any event, whether we believe it, or whether we are in the know, will not change God's Prophetic Time Clock, and that We will experience moving events in God's appointed time.

What should we be doing and how shall we occupy until Christ returns? I think, first, that Christ would remind us that the harvest is plentiful. In fact He said in John 4:35, "There are yet 4 months, and then cometh harvest? Behold, I say unto you, lift up your eyes, and look on the fields; for they are white already to harvest."

Dear friend, if you're ever going to do anything for the Kingdom of God, do it now. For Jesus told us that the night cometh when no man could work. Most of the things, pursuits, and ambitions that we find ourselves pursuing is only wood, hay, and stubble. They're not going to stand the test at the end. We should look for the precious stones and the things that will not burn up. But, so many Christian believers seem to have the fatalistic mindset that conditions are so bad, and the Rapture is so near, so we'll just set and wait for the Rapture to come. It's like circle the wagons, get in our little social groups, become fatalistic.

My friend, we live in the greatest generation that has ever lived on this earth. We have unprecedented opportunities to be effective for Christ. We must develop overcoming faith. For

the Bible tells us that we are to be more than conquerors through Christ Jesus. Many prophetic teachers are telling us that the year 2007 is the year of destiny. Some spiritual leaders are telling us that because of the conditions in the Middle East that we are heading to a very serious Middle East crisis that will upset the balance of many things in America. America that's addicted to oil, and still very much dependent on foreign oil.

I would challenge every believer to make a new commitment to become still before God, spend some extra time alone, uninterrupted, some real serious quality, quiet time, and ask the Holy Spirit what would God have you do. Spend extra time in prayer, an extra 30 minutes per day. If you will become still before God and ask Him to show you what you should do to occupy until Jesus comes, and then be obedient to the leading of the Holy Spirit to be cleansed and filled with the Power of the Supernatural Holy Spirit in-filling.
